

THE PARISH COUNCIL OF SEDBERGH

Minutes of the Extraordinary Meeting of the Parish Council of Sedbergh held in The People's Hall, Sedbergh on 9th June 2011

1. Apologies: Apologies were received from Cllr Sedgwick and were accepted by the meeting.

2. Declarations of Interest

3. Sale of 72 Main Street

The meeting was updated with what had happened at the meeting of the YDNPA on 31st May and on the position of the open space to the west of 72 Main Street.

Public participation was then taken

After the public participation it was resolved that: -

1. A letter be sent to the YDNP expressing the Parish Council's views subsequent to the YDNPA's meeting on 31 May 2011.
2. A group, initially of Parish Councillors, be set up to design and lead the action plan from now until December to save the building for community use.
3. The Parish Council inquire of the Park what arrangements they were putting in place to ensure that open space to the west of the building remained as such.
4. The Parish Council write to the Park and object now to the sale of the open space and to encourage members of the community to do the same after the appearance of the advert in a newspaper.

4. Public participation

Some 16 members of the public including Mr Blackie from Hawes who is a Member of the YDNP. The points raised have been collected and ordered into a separate document.
